- Authorization to prepare specification and bid Contract 21-019, Lead Service Line Replacement. Bid opening is scheduled for Tuesday, November 16, 2021.
- Authorization to approve the 2020 Audit, as presented at the regular meeting of September 28,2021.
- Authorization to extend the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, one vear 2022, with the U.W.U.A., A.F.L.-C.I.O., Local 191.
- Authorization to prepare specification and bid, Contract 21-021, Janitorial Service. Contract term is one year with the option of three one-year.
 extensions.
- Authorization to approve Change Order #1, Contract 21-07, Hawkins Avenue Mainline Replacement, in the Borough of North Braddock. Change order reflects final quantity adjustments. Contract increase is \$6,419.75.
- Requesting authorization to award Contract 21-020, Furnishing and Delivering of Water Treatment Chemicals, to the lowest responsible bidder. Auction is scheduled for Wednesday, November 10, 2021, Award to be ratified at the November 23, 2021, regular scheduled meeting.
- Requesting approval to exercise renewal option Contract 2020-13, Furnishing and Delivering of Water Treatment Chemicals, Liquid Aluminum Sulfate to USALCO at the price of \$561.12 per dry ton and \$274.00 wet ton delivered. Renewal is for calendar year commencing January 1, 2022. All other contract terms and conditions to remain the same.
- Approval of Resolution 2021-02 with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the reimbursement of costs, incurred in relocating water line facilities impacted with the Ardmore Boulevard proposed culvert project. Reimbursement is 75% for all costs, less any betterments.
- Authorize the Executive Director to request, from the Pennsylvania
 Department of Environmental Protection, an extension of the Consent Order
 for the closure of two underground storage facilities. The proposed extension
 request is to June 30, 2022.

ms consultants - MONTHLY ENGINEER'S REPORT

PENNVEST LEAD SERVICE LINE PROJECT

The project was advertised on October 22nd and bids will be opened in mid-November. The settlement is scheduled for February 2022. All letters have been sent to property owners. Responses have been positive and we are receiving between 5 and 10 per day with a few phone calls or emails. I will provide an update as to the received letters at the Board Meeting.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT GROUNDWATER INVESTIGATION

The repair of the drain line with an offset joint was completed on October 11th. Initial indications are that the groundwater level in the backyards of Faybern has decreased. We will continue to monitor and to identify other options for reducing groundwater levels.

RAMSEY STORAGE BUILDING

Waiting for Wilkinsburg Borough to approve drawings.

FOURTH STREET WATER LINE (MONROEVILLE)

Preconstruction meeting occurred last week and construction started on October 25th. Project should be completed prior to December.

WALL AVENUE WATER LINE REPLACEMENT (PITCAIRN)

Project is completed. The final cost exceeded the original contract amount by \$2,502. A final reconciliation change order will need to be approved.

BRINTON MANOR TANK REHABILITATION

Tank in service. Remaining items delayed until November. Final payment being withheld until remaining items completed.

NADINE PUMP STATION MOTOR AND VFD

Project ready for bid.

ALUM STORAGE TANKS AT WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Concrete foundation work is complete, metal building ordered, and alum tanks ordered. No additional work can occur until metal building arrives. A letter requesting an extension to the COA has been developed.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT CLARIFIER COATING

Project to be bid during December 2021 for April 2023 start date.

DUFFIELD AREA WATER LINE PROJECT (PENN HILLS)

Project bid being delayed due to pipe shortage issues. .
