Wilksburg-Penn Joint Water Authority Partners with Service Line Warranties of America to Offer Homeowners Peace of Mind on Costly Service Line Repairs

Wilksburg, PA, 10/27/2025, The Wilksburg-Penn Joint Water Authority (WPJWA) announced today a new partnership with Service Line Warranties of America (SLWA), a HomeServe company, which offers affordable protection plans for homeowners facing unexpected water and sewer line repairs.

Many homeowners are surprised to learn that they are responsible for the water and sewer lines running from their home to the public connection. When these lines fail due to age, shifting soil, or tree root intrusion, replacements can cost thousands of dollars out of pocket.

Through this new program, eligible WPJWA homeowner customers may enroll in optional service plans that provide:

- Up to \$8,500 per repair call for covered water or sewer line repairs.
- Unlimited service calls with no deductibles.
- 24/7 emergency hotline to schedule repairs.
- Dispatch of local, licensed, insured plumbers.
- Affordable monthly rates starting at \$5.75, with a 10% first-year savings if both the water and sewer line plans are selected.

“This program is about protecting our customers from costly surprises,” said Brian Bianchi Executive Director of WPJWA. “Unexpected service line breaks can place a heavy financial burden on families. By partnering with SLWA, we can help ensure that our customers have access to reliable, local repair services and peace of mind.

Program participation is voluntary and choosing not to participate will not affect WPJWA services. Plans are administered by SLWA, and no public funds are used to promote or manage the program.

SLWA currently partners with over 1,100 municipalities and utilities nationwide to provide homeowners with trusted emergency repair coverage.
